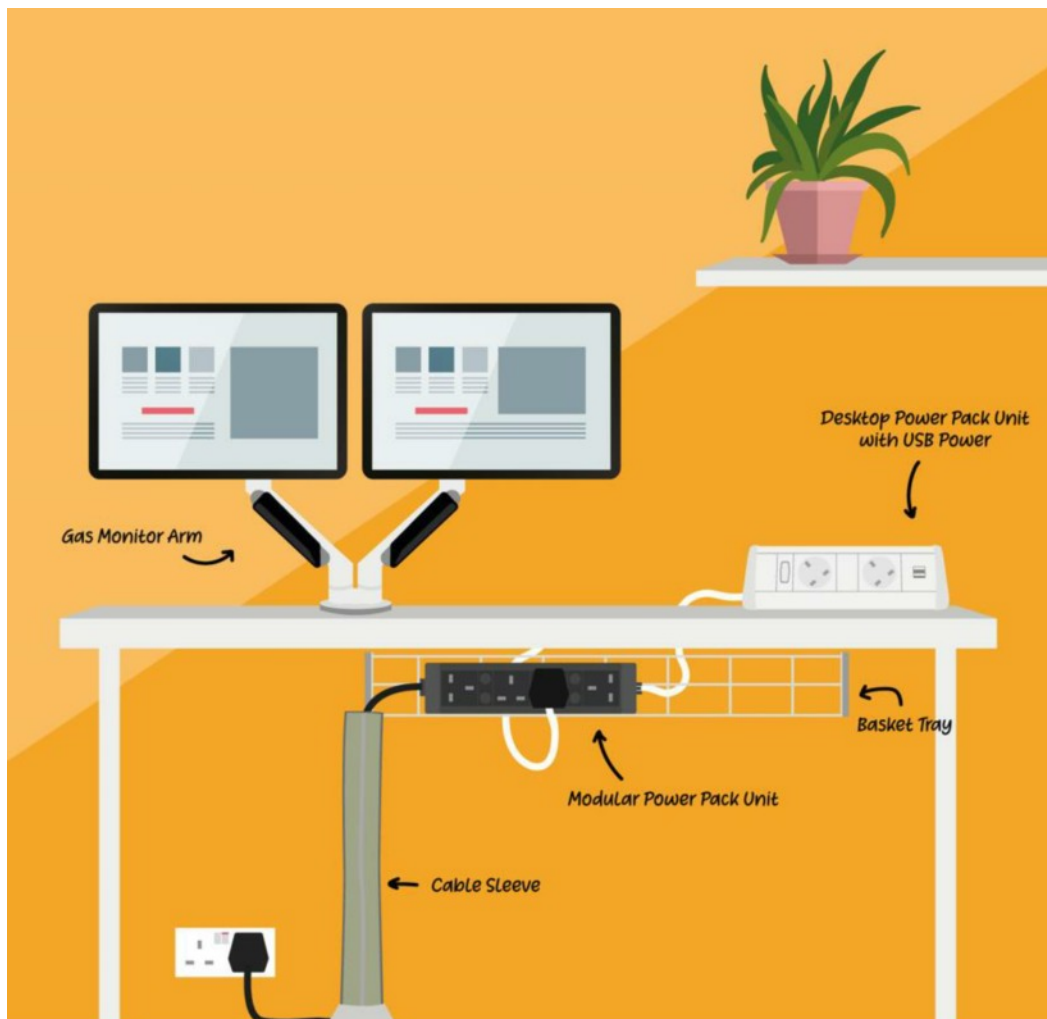

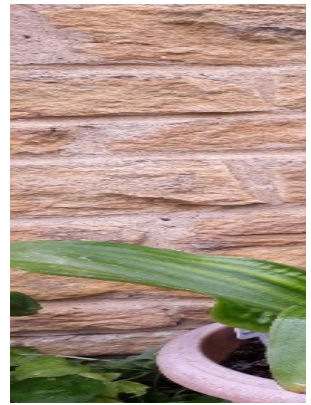

Ecton Remembered

From time to time I check in to your website to refresh my childhood memories of living at Manor Farm Ecton. I lived in the village from 1938 to 1955. I recall fondly the villagers, the buildings, the church and the surrounding countryside. It was a happy time.

I have great memories of Sui Rands, Vera Middleton, Betty Cunningham. I am now 85 years old. As a child I used to play with David Dicks and his brothers, Tom and Richard! I am happy to know that the village has not been swallowed up by Northampton.

During WWII I attended the village school. I remember being scared to death of Headmaster Mr. Simcoe and his cane, which he was not hesitant to use. My first teacher was Mrs. Spendlove. She was a darling. Then I had a teacher we called Mardy Dick. She slapped my legs and hands when I talked too much, I remember. When the war ended I took the bus to Northampton to school, waiting outside The World's End for a ride to town.

I remember the Canadian soldiers being camped out in the fields, and Canadian officers staying in our spare bedroom. I learned a lot about the Sothebys from your website. As a child I knew them, but did not know much about their history. I went to Sunday school in the village church and sang in the choir for about six years. I loved the stained glass windows.

In those days I never would have dreamed that I would be living in Havana, Cuba and Miami, USA! (not to mention San Francisco, Calif and Boston, Mass.)

I intend to keep checking in on your site to see what is going on and to remember the old days.

Sunbathing Birds

You may see birds on the ground with their feathers fluffed up and wings and tails spread out “sunbathing”.

This helps to spread preen oil across feathers and drives out parasites.

They may also be seen with their beaks open.

Birds don't have sweat glands like us, so they pant to control temperature.

A shallow dish of water in the garden (refreshed regularly) will provide birds with a much needed drink in the hot weather and a bath to keep their feathers in good condition.

Many birds are “in moult” at the moment and are not able to fly as easily, so they hide away and can look very tatty!

Hopefully the weather will cool down during August, so we can all be out enjoying nature and summer pursuits in safety and sleep at night.

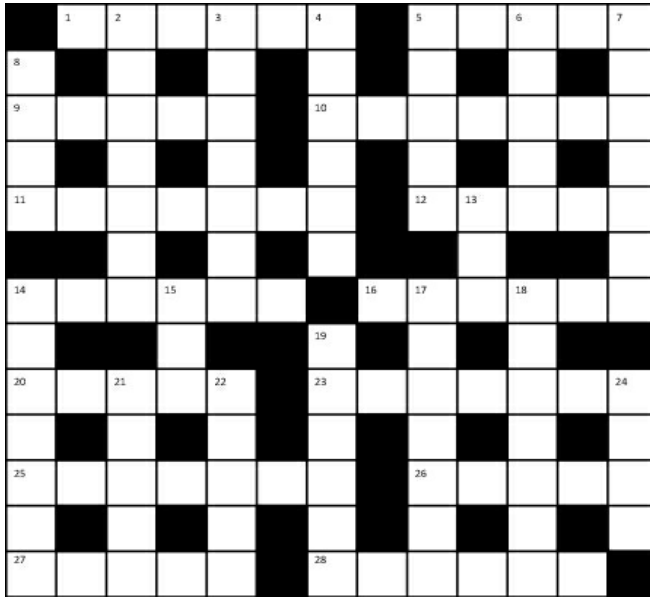
